1. Counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners had preferred a writ petition being SBCWP No.5406/2026 (Dr. Monika Lakkad & Ors. v. State of Rajasthan & Ors.); wherein, the Coordinate Bench, vide order dated 17.02.2026 had directed the respondents to provide appropriate posting to the petitioners at the Directorate or in other suitable place while also relieving the petitioners forthwith so as to enable them to join Senior Residency Course pursuant to the orders dated 04.02.2026 and 21.02.2026. He further submits that despite the said order being passed in favour of the petitioners, respondents have not relieved the petitioner to join Senior Residency Course and on the other hand, respondents have also reflected the seat of the Senior Residency Course as vacant in the second round of counseling, which is reflected from the Notification dated 24.03.2026 as well as seat matrix dated 27.03.2026 appended to the said notification.

2. Counsel Mr. Tanuj Jain, associate to Mr. Mukesh Dave, learned AGC, puts in appearance on behalf of respondents, thus, not need to issue notices. Counsel for the respondents, prays for and is granted two weeks' time to complete his instructions.



3. In the meanwhile, the seat allotted to the petitioners, as a Senior Residents, shall be kept vacant for the petitioners.
